

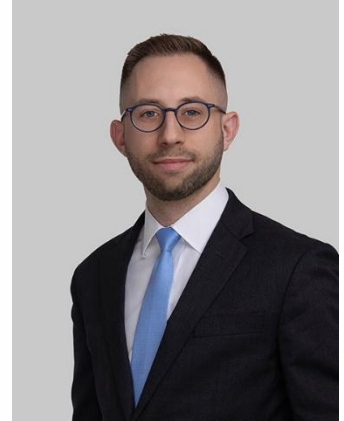
Justin D. Beck
